

A new Community Interest Company sets up in the area, providing a one-stop shop for retro-fit work. They will organise loans and grants, find builders and supervise the work. Their prices are very reasonable.

The Government updates the Green Deal. It now offers 50% grants for all approved measures and interest free loans of up to £35,000.

The expanding market for retrofitting houses has led to a reduction in prices across the board. Knock 25% off the prices on any of the cards you still hold.

The Government introduces a white goods scrappage scheme – 30% discount when trading in any fridge, freezer, washing machine or dishwasher over 8 years old for a top-rated replacement.
